Till now, more than 17 Lac persons have been certified in Apparel Job roles and AMH SSC had been declared as single largest employment providing sector in the PMKVY by providing jobs to 21% of the total employment arranged under the scheme. The Council has two State of Art Centres of Excellence (COEs) at Tirupur and New Delhi which cater to the needs of the Industry, especially in upskilling the existing workforce in the Middle management level.
